



Welcome to Beekeeping | Workshop Series

In this hands-on workshop you will learn the basics of starting and managing a home apiary with Burleigh Sunflower & Cliff Sunflower. Burleigh is co-owner of Erskine's and a beekeeper with 30 years of beekeeping experience. Cliff Sunflower is a Certified Master Beekeeper (and Burleigh's father), with over 30 years of experience! Burleigh & Cliff will introduce participants to the world of bees, the hive they live in and the tools needed to care for them throughout the year. The course meets over five sessions.

For Who: Never ever beekeepers and beginner beekeepers. Ages 8 and up: ages 8-14 must be accompanied by a paying adult, ages 15 and up may attend without a chaperone.

Where: Split between Erskine's/Chester Town Hall and Burleigh's Apiary at Treehog Farm.

When:

- * April 14 (Sunday), 1 – 4pm, Indoors at Chester Town Hall. Intro to the honeybee lifecycle and beekeeping equipment.
- * April 27 (Saturday), 11am – 1pm at Treehog Farm. Hiving Package Bees.
- * May 11 (Saturday) 9am – 12pm at Treehog Farm. Spring in the hive!
- * July 13 (Saturday) 9am – 12pm at Treehog Farm. Varroa mite management and treatments.
- * October 19 (Saturday) 10am – 1pm at Treehog Farm. Preparing your hives for winter.
