Kennebec. Top all-purpose potato. Ideal for frying, baking and boiling. Thin, smooth skin and smooth white flesh make these oval potatoes an all-purpose pantry staple. Young tubers are tasty for creaming and full-size spuds are excellent for frying, boiling, mashing or baking. Stores well.

Superior. A parent of Kennebec originally bred for chipping, Superior is a medium-early maturing variety with moderately high yields. Buff colored skin with smooth to slightly flaked white flesh. Stores well.

Dark Red Norland. Thin red skins and small eyes. White flesh is tasty fried and in potato pancakes. Produces extra-large tubers. Early season variety. Red Norland's compact plants make it an ideal potato variety for smaller gardens. An excellent potato for boiling and salads. Shows good resistance to scab.

Red Pontiac. White flesh and thin, red skins. Performs well in heavy soils. Top-notch mashing potato! Produces solid tubers with thin red skin, shallow eyes and crisp white flesh. A good keeper—has long-lasting quality.

Burbank Russet. Russet skin, shallow eyes, and white flesh; great taste and perfect baked, fried or boiled. This long-storing, scab-resistant potato needs a consistent moisture supply.

Yukon Gold. Yellow-fleshed with rich flavor, thin, gold skins with shallow eyes. Produces high yields and stores well. Produces a big, early, great-tasting crop for baking or mashing. Sprout resistant, super for storage.

Adirondak Blue. Medium purple skin and flesh. High yields of large, oblong tubers with consistent, blue-violet flesh that hold their color when cooked. High in antioxidants!

French Fingerling. Pink skins with yellow, red-flecked flesh. These fingerlings are known for their gourmet flavor and are best boiled or roasted. Somewhat resistant to scab.

Banana Fingerling. Yellow skin and golden flesh, bananas have a smooth, waxy texture, sweet flavor and are quite savory after just steaming or boiling – salt and butter optional!

Magic Molly Fingerling. A unique fingerling with purple skin and solid dark purple flesh that retains its color even when boiled. Excellent flavor, superior when roasted.
