All poultry are shipped to us on the day they hatch. All chickens have been vaccinated against Marek's Disease.

We encourage you to order early; pre-payment in full is required to place and secure an order. Prices listed are cash/check discounted. Credit Card sales add 3%. Quantities are limited, and orders will be filled on a first come/first served basis.

Arrival Dates: ARE APPROXIMATE and based on chicks arriving 2 days following shipment (sometimes they arrive in one day, occasionally it takes longer.) Very occasionally hatcheries are unable to ship on our reserved dates. We will update customers with any changes from the hatchery as soon as we are aware of them.

Pick up agreement: Due to lack of brooder space and the daily expense of keeping birds in the store, we ask that you pick up your poultry within 24 hours of the time they arrive. **We will call you when they are ready for pickup!** Birds left longer will cost \$.50 per bird, per day that we must raise them. Birds left over 5 days will be considered abandoned and eligible for re-sale. There are no refunds for unclaimed birds.

Curbside pickup will be available for poultry orders; please call to schedule if you prefer this option.

Erskine's Grain & Garden will provide refunds only if (a) we are able to re-sell an order cancelled by the customer or (b) we are unable to fill the customer's order as placed.

BROILER CHICKENS

FREEDOM RANGER

These broiler chickens are perfect for free-range environments. They grow at a moderate rate (5-6 pounds in 9-11 weeks), which results in succulent meat that has more yellow omega 3 fat and less saturated fat than faster-growing breeds. These broiler chicks will grow to have either red or tricolored feathers, with yellow shanks, skin, and beaks.

CORNISH CROSS

This broiler is a cross between a Cornish chicken and a Plymouth Rock chicken. Cornish Crosses grow quickly, boasting excellent feed conversion with maximum white meat yield. Results can vary, but at 6 to 8 weeks of age you can expect processed weights of 4.5 – 6 lbs. White plumage and lack of pin feathers help make harvesting a breeze.

TURKEYS

ARTISAN GOLD

Hybrid breed that is smaller in size and slower growing than a traditional commercial turkey. Black feathers, unique coloring in the face and feet, long black legs, and a pronounced beak. Thrives in a free-range or custom environment where it can express natural tendencies such as roaming and roosting. Males can reach 17 lbs live weight at 16 weeks, females 11.5 lbs. Ideal for a smaller, richer flavored Thanksgiving bird.

BROAD BREASTED BRONZE

Underneath its beautiful bronze feathers is an efficient, robust turkey with excellent conformation and high meat quality due to natural fat layering. Delivers competitive feed conversion. Males can reach 33 lbs live weight at 16 weeks, females 23 lbs. They will not breed naturally and have a traditional taste.

BROAD BREASTED WHITE

The traditional Thanksgiving turkey, this compact bird has large breast proportions, and is best suited for those interested in a heavy bird designed for total profitability. Offers excellent feed conversion. Males can reach 33 lbs live weight at 16 weeks, females 23 lbs. Will not reproduce naturally.
