

Pitch the Pots! Starting Seeds in Soil Blocks

What?

A workshop with Melissa Post, a 20+ year organic CSA gardener and Chester resident. Melissa is excited to share her unique methods for growing a garden from seed in this hands-on introduction to starting plants indoors with soil blocks.

For Whom?

For those with zero seed starting experience, or those with some experience but who want to learn more about the soil blocking technique and sharpen their knowledge of starting garden plants from seed indoors. Limit 10 participants.

Benefits of soil blocking include:

- Using less (or possibly zero) single use plastics
- Creating healthier, more vigorous transplants due to oxygenated, "air-pruned" roots
- Reducing transplant shock for your seedlings
