ONION & SHALLOT SETS Small, dry, immature bulbs grown the season before. Once replanted they resume growing.

Stuttgarter. Medium-large yellow onion with golden bronze skin, firm. Thick, slightly flat shape. Stores well. Harvest immature for scallions/green onions!

Weathersfield. Large, flattened globes with deep purple red skin.

Nero. F1 hybrid, traditional shaped shallot with a copper pink outer shell and pink colored flesh. Excellent storage, up to 12 months.

ONION PLANTS Field-grown, spring dug plants. Plants arrive as dormant starts — expect them to be dry and/or pale in color due to dormancy and shipping.

Patterson. F1 Hybrid. Medium-large, blocky bulbs with dark yellow skin and thin necks that dry quickly. Extremely long storage onion.

Ailsa Craig. A classic mild onion with excellent size potential. Jumbo to colossal, round to teardrop-shaped bulbs with light yellow skins. Use fresh or for short-term storage.

Redwing. F1 Hybrid. Uniform, large onions with deep red color. Thick skin, very hard bulbs for long storage. Consistent internal color.
